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Information About Colorado City/Rye Lions Scholarship

Purpose: The Colorado City/Rye Lions Club takes pride in serving youth within our community. The scholarship has been established and will be awarded based on financial need foremost, along with academic achievement, and also past involvement in community, school, and civic activities. The scholarship may be used at any **Colorado** institution of higher education.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a graduating senior at Rye High School.
2. Demonstrate a strong desire to successfully pursue a higher education degree in Colorado leading to a productive career.
3. Meet the minimum academic requirements (listed below).

Academic Requirements: At the time of submission the applicant must have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00, and an ACT composite score of 20.

Amount and Duration of the Scholarship Award: The amount of the award is \$1,000.00 total taking a minimum of 12 academic credits each semester at a Colorado institution of higher education. The \$1,000.00 scholarship may be used entirely in one (1) semester or divided into two (2) concurrent semesters. In addition, the student must **not** be on academic probation during the two (2) semesters or the scholarship is revoked.
