TO ALL MASONIC VOCATIONAL GRANT APPLICANTS:

Dear Student:

The attached Vocational Grant Application Form and Fact Sheet are for your personal use in applying for our Vocational Grant. It is your responsibility to see that all instructions are carefully followed.

You will need to contact a representative from your assigned Masonic Lodge for a personal interview. You should do this prior to February 1st in order to avoid being part of the last minute rush. The representatives contact information will be released on our website at www.cmbfa.org on or before December 1, 2011.

You should have all the required application material available for the Lodge representative to review at the time of interview. Please see the check list items 1 thru 6 on the FACT SHEET for a list of all the required materials. If you did not apply for FAFSA, make sure to indicate such on Pg. 3 of your application and disregard item 5 of the Check List.

Following the interview, you may submit your application and materials online by visiting our website at www.cmbfa.org. You will need to follow all of the website prompts to gain access to our online submission process. If you do not have a complete application you WILL NOT be able to submit your application electronically.

** Scanned application signatures are acceptable for electronic submissions.

If you are mailing your application all materials MUST BE addressed as follows:

Be sure to use the proper postage. I cannot accept any postage-due mailings.

MATERIAL MUST BE SUMBITTED AND/OR RECEIVED NO LATER THEN MARCH 15, 2012.

Remember, this is your application and therefore your responsibility to submit it on time. Others may offer to do it for you but they cannot have the same level of interest that you have. Your application packet will not be returned to you; in the event that you are not a selected recipient all documents are destroyed at the conclusion of our committee's selection process.

FACT SHEET FOR APPLICANTS OF COLORADO MASONS' BENEVOLENT FUND **VOCATIONAL GRANTS**

PURPOSE: These grants are intended to provide financial assistance to deserving students. In your planning you should not assume that a grant has been awarded until you are officially notified by the grant committee.

AWARD: We award one-time grants of up to \$3,000.00. These grants are intended to assist in obtaining a vocational skill from a vocational training program within the state of Colorado. The program must be approved by a recognized accreditation committee. Grants are awarded without reference to race, religion, sex, national origin, or Masonic relationship.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY:

- 1. You must be a graduating Colorado Public High School Senior.
- 2. You must attend an approved vocational training program within the State of Colorado.

CHECKLIST: (Please arrange your packet in this order)

- 1. Complete all three pages of the application form.
- 2. Write a personal letter including the following:
 - a. Your goals and objectives for the future;
 - b. Why you require financial assistance; and,
 - c. Why you feel you should be selected.
- 3. A grade transcript covering your entire high school career.
- 4. A letter of acceptance from the approved vocational training program listed on the application.
- 5. A copy of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Student Aid Report (SAR).

Please include either the complete SAR report if you have received it or the latest complete FAFSA application (All pages).

6. Four (4) Letters of Recommendation should accompany the application. Letters should be from personal acquaintances, employers, clergy or teachers. It is best not to have all the letters from teachers. They should be from people who have known your family over a period of time. Letters need not be in separate envelopes.

FACT SHEET FOR APPLICANTS (cont.) VOCATIONAL GRANT

7. You must arrange for a personal interview with one of the members of the Masonic Lodge that sponsor's your attending high school.

Lodge Contact Information will be available on our website on or before December 1, 2011.

Once your contact information has been released, please make immediate contact with your assigned Lodge for your interview! Interview dates may be preselected by your Lodge and your advanced knowledge of these dates are extremely important!

You should complete checklist items 1 thru 6 prior to the interview and have them available at the interview.

- 8. Following your interview, you may submit your application via electronic submission or, if necessary, via United States Mail.
- 9. You may submit your application and materials online by visiting our website at www.cmbfa.org. You will need to follow all of the website prompts to gain access to our online submission process. If you do not have a complete application you WILL NOT be able to submit your application electronically.
- ** Scanned application signatures are acceptable for electronic submissions.
- 10. If you are mailing your application all materials MUST BE addressed as follows:
