The Garone-Nicksich Foundation Scholarship is granted to graduates of high schools located in the City of Pueblo or the County of Pueblo who will continue their education at an accredited 4-year degree granting college or university. Grants will be made for a school year if the Applicant files a timely Application and is selected by the Scholarship Committee.

Scholarships will be in the amount of \$1,000.00 for a school year and will be divided into two equal installments of \$500.00, with the first half being paid to the school in September and the second half being paid to the school in January. In order for a student to receive the second half of a scholarship grant, the student must attain a 2.5 GPA for the previous semester. This scholarship is not renewable since it is intended to give a high school student an opportunity to get started in college. Therefore, a student may not reapply for a grant in subsequent years.

The Scholarship Committee is permitted, but not required, to consider an Applicant's financial needs. A copy of the Financial Aid Form used by the college of the student's choice to determine eligibility for financial need should be completed and attached to this Application Form.

The Scholarship Committee will not consider an Application from a high school student with less than a 3.2 GPA or less than a 22 A.C.T. Score.

A student should submit a letter from one or more teachers or counselors indicating in detail why the student is deserving of a scholarship. The student should also supply whatever factual information is available concerning the student's academic achievements and school activities in order to support the student's scholarship application.

Successful scholarship recipients will be notified by letter and by announcement in *The Pueblo Chieftain*.

The Application Package must be received by the following office no later than 4:00 p.m. on March 29, 2012.
