The Harold and Ruth Robinson Foundation will grant several \$1,500.00 scholarships to graduates of high schools located in the City of Pueblo or the County of Pueblo who will attend an accredited 4 year degree-granting college in Colorado. Grants will be made for a school year if the applicant files a timely application and is selected by the Scholarship Committee. The scholarship may be used only for tuition, fees, and books and is not renewable.

Grants for a full school year will be divided into two portions of \$ 750.00 each, with the first half being paid to the school in September and the second half being paid to the school in January. In order for a student to receive the second half of a scholarship grant, the student must attain a 2.5 GPA for the previous semester and supply the Foundation with a copy of the student's transcript.

A student should submit a letter from a teacher or counselor indicating in detail why the student is deserving of a scholarship. The student should also supply whatever factual information is available concerning the student's academic achievements, school and outside activities in order to support the student's scholarship application. As need is a consideration, financial information and a copy of the student's financial aid application and required enclosures must be included. Do not include Income Tax forms.

The Scholarship Committee will not consider an application from a high school student with less than a 3.2 GPA or less than a 22 ACT score.

Successful scholarship recipients will be notified by letter and by announcement in *The Pueblo Chieftain*.

The completed application package must be received by the Foundation before 5:00 o'clock p.m. on March 30, 2012.
