3. NDIA will accept nominations from any source in the prescribed format.
4. NDIA Rocky Mountain Chapter Scholarship Committee will make the final selection(s). Decisions of this Committee are final.
5. Selection criteria will include, but not be limited to, academic achievement, community involvement, leadership and motivation.

In addition to this application, please include the following in your submittal:

1. Complete official transcript with college entrance examination scores (ACT and/or SAT).
2. One page personal essay, authored by the applicant, describing intended course of study and goals.
3. Letter of recommendation from one or more academic officials at the high school you are attending.
4. Letter of nomination from someone, other than a family member or school teacher/administrator, providing background on nonacademic issues such as community service, demonstrated leadership, etc.
5. College acceptance letter(s), if available.

Scholarship awards will be made totally on a nondiscriminatory basis. Neither Scholarship Committee members nor their immediate families are eligible for a scholarship award and cannot benefit financially in any way from this program.

Scholarship applications must be submitted by mail and postmarked no later than Monday, April 16, 2012.
